We have known this lovely couple for many years and acknowledge the important work that they are doing in training church leaders in very difficult circumstances.

Candido is co-ordinating the work of 4 other teachers, and together they have 350 students. He is currently sharing an office with three other Christian workers.

Mozambique is desperately poor and there are many problems in the country. Candido himself has been the victim of a great deal of theft (3 TVs, car parts, cheques, etc.) and has had his telephone disconnected because someone broke into his office and used the telephone to call South Africa and run up a large bill! Yet he remains positive.

AMEN have already provided him with some money – he has been granted land by the Government and now plans to build a Leadership Training School on this site to act as a permanent base for his ministry – operating under the name CEFOBE (Centre FOR Bible Evangelism) .
