

News from the Village Missionary Movement – January 2009



Greetings in Jesus Name.

Thank you for prayer and encouragement. We pray that God will help us to reach these goals soon as the need of the hour is great. God blessed the two camp we held in the past days. I will share about these camps in this newsletter.

LEADERSHIP CAMP I FOR BOYS:



1. 45 youth boys attended. They are from 15 different villages.
2. All the participants recommitted their lives to Lord Jesus Christ.
3. Seven youths committed their lives to full time ministry.
4. All the participants have committed to form Philip gospel team in their area and do ministry for at least two days in a month.
5. One participant who does business committed to support a missionary every month.
6. Every one committed to start prayer cells in a weekly basis in their respective villages.
7. Every one committed to bring youths from their villages to the one day camp we have planned in April 29 (We are praying and planning to gather 5000 youths). Also they will select volunteers for the VVBS in 1000 villages in month of May.
8. The Catholic Father who is in charge of the campus was so impressed about our ministry that he not only made concessions but also promised to support by monthly offering. (I think you remember him as we had AMEN meet there.)

LEADERSHIP CAMP II FOR GIRLS:

1. We expected only 50 girls but 110 girls attended from 26 villages.
2. 40 participants committed to Baptism.
3. 30 girls committed to participate as volunteers in the coming VVBS (Vacational Bible Studies for children).
4. 32 youth girls committed to full-time work in future after their study.
5. Every one committed to start prayer cells in a weekly basis in their respective villages. Also they have committed to do small savings for supporting ministry in one other village.
6. Some committed to do hospital ministry in their regions.
7. The watch man of the campus was touched about our missionary work and promised to contribute Rs.100 every month.



To add a dramatic tone, we received a phone call that there is a bomb in the meeting hall. It was latter proved false. The mischief persons called on Police also. So many Police officers came and enquired about our meeting. When we explained what we are doing, they were convinced. So the meeting continued with Police security. One of them a lady Police heard all the messages with interest and at the end asked us to pray for her.

The actual expense for the two camps was Rs.54,000. (The actual budget was Rs.60,000). Funds miraculously came from various sources. We have a small shortage of Rs 17,000 only. Please pray for the needs and also for the participants and for the follow up work.
